Initial agreement term will be for period of (2) months at a cost of \$180,000.00 per month (or \$90,000 per entity). Approval to purchase is ordered as a discretionary exemption (per Tex. Local Gov't Code Section 262.024 (a)(1-2)) due to exigent and emergency circumstances necessitating monoclonal treatment to preserve and protect the public health of the residents of Ellis County.
