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## PERMIT INFORMATION SHEET

*No person shall perform or authorize Construction or Substantial Improvement within the unincorporated areas of Ellis County without first securing a permit. Substantial Improvement includes a change in occupancy classification involving a change in the purpose or level of activity in a building.*

In order to obtain a permit, the following items must be submitted:

1. A completed Building Permit Application.
2. Two complete sets of construction plan for each building, drawn to scale and must include:
  - a. The types of construction materials.
  - b. The location of all exits, the distance between exits, and the exit dimensions.
  - c. The location of any fire alarm equipment, automatic sprinklers, emergency lighting, fire extinguishers, exit signs and smoke detectors required to meet the Fire Code.
3. Two complete sets of site plans indicating
  - a. The location of the building on the property and property lines
  - b. Location of any fire hydrants
  - c. Location of fire lanes/fire access roads, storage areas and parking areas.
4. A permit fee in accordance with Section 8.3, Table I of the Fire Code.

The plans will be reviewed by the Fire Code Official and, if necessary, revisions will be marked up on the plans. Upon approval, the plans will be stamped and one (1) set of plans will be retained at the Fire Marshal’s Office. The remaining set must be kept at the construction site. A Building Permit will also be issued and must remain at the construction site and must be visible from the roadway. ***Address numbers assigned by the 911 Coordinator must also be visible and legible from the roadway during the entire construction process.***

When the construction process is completed and the building is ready to be occupied, a “Request for Final Inspection” form must be completed and notarized. Once the form has been received by the Fire Code Official, a final inspection will be scheduled. ***A building cannot be occupied until it has passed a final inspection and received a Certificate of Occupancy and Completion.***

BUILDING PERMITS
<b>BUILDING PERMIT</b> - The fee is based on the building type and reflects the cost of inspections, and the issuing of the permit and final certificate of compliance under this code. The building type is related to size and occupancy classification.
For occupancy classifications A through S that are less than 500 sf, the fee is \$75.00
For occupancy classification A through S that are less than 5,000 sf the fee is \$250.00
For occupancy classifications A through S that are equal to or greater than 5,000 sf but less than 12,000 sf: the fee is \$500.
For occupancy classifications A through S equal to or greater than 12,000 sf but less than 50,000 sf: the fee is \$750
For occupancy classifications A through S that are equal to or greater than 50,000 sf, the fee is \$1,000.
For occupancies classified as U: the fee is \$250.00.
Publicly funded construction projects \$500 plus \$25 per hour.
